Description:

State DOTs must plan and implement a wide range of projects across urban, suburban and rural landscapes. Urban environments present a particular challenge to State DOTs as they look to satisfy a wide number of constituents and jurisdictions in densely developed locations. TRB's Committee on Transportation Issues in Major U.S. Cities (ABE30) is seeking abstracts for presentations at TRB's 2014 Annual Meeting that describe examples of the Best State DOT Projects in Urban Areas. The presentations may examine, but are not restricted to, the following subject areas:

- The processes by which the project was conceived, designed, financed, organized, and/or completed;
- The collaborations (and the reasons for them) that occurred between the State DOT, transit agencies, MPOs, and/or city transportation agencies; and
- How these processes and/or collaborations may mark a departure from business as usual for the respective State DOT.
